JOURNAL REVIEW PROCESS

The review process involves the following stages:

- 1. Preliminary review process: This is conducted by the administrative staff of the NJPBR at the Faculty of Pharmacy, University of Maiduguri. A manuscript that passes this stage, will be forwarded to the Editorial Board for subsequent stages of the review process.
- 2. Plagiarism check: A research article has to earn a score of not more than 10% to pass this stage.
- 3. Payment of processing fee: An article that has successfully pass through the plagiarism check, will be required to pay for processing fee of Five thousand Naira (5,000.00). Payment is to be made to only NJPBR Access Bank account.
- 4. Peer review stage: A minimum of two reviewers will be contacted to conduct double blind review of the manuscript.
- 5. Payment of publication fee: Authors whose manuscript has scaled through the plagiarism check, will be required to pay thirty thousand Naira (30,000.00) only, as publication fee. In all the afore-mentioned stages, editors will be in continuous touch with authors and reviewers.
